

Boating and Marina Electrical Safety

Consider having Equipment Leakage Circuit Interrupters (ELCI) installed on boats to protect nearby swimmers from potential electricity leakage into water surrounding your boat.

Have your boats electrical system inspected and upgraded by a certified marine electrician regularly.



If you feel a tingle while swimming, the water may be electrified. Get out of the water as soon as possible, avoiding the use of any metal objects such as ladders.

Never use cords that are frayed or damaged or that have had the prongs removed or altered. Have Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCI) installed on your boat if possible.
